Dear OZS Families,

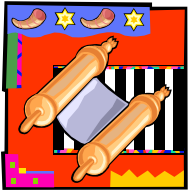

PLEASE respond by the deadlines indicated (not all deadlines are the same).

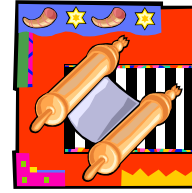
- **High Holy Days Service Schedule**
